President Jan Rosenberg opened the meeting at 10:05 a.m. and called on Don Haberman to give the opening prayer.

The minutes of the last meeting were omitted from the September newsletter and will be included for action at the next Guild meeting.

Reports

Sunshine: Jan noted that our Sunshine Lady Pat Van Hooser is not attending meetings at this time but reported that Peggy Masterman recently had surgery on her good eye, Brenda Vivieros is dealing with several family issues, David Carver is now home and continuing to heal, and Paula Buzenius's mother passed away. If you wish to send information to Pat Van Hooser, please send it in a text. She is unable to hear phone messages or conversations.

Membership: Darlene reported that we currently have 67 active members which includes one new member, Jacob Shirk, who joined today. There are 21 present today, including 2 guests.

1st Vice President: Jan thanked 1st Vice President Don Haberman for persevering with his task of organizing programs this year even though we were not able to have many.

2nd Vice President Jan O'Neill: As everyone knows, the traditional Fall Art Festival has been put on hold. Tentatively, the library has been reserved for a Spring Festival April 23-25. The theme will be Color Magic and members are encouraged to submit ideas for Festival Posters based on the theme. Post card announcements were recently sent to all

patrons from the 2019 show advising them of the change in dates, etc.

New Business:

Change of meeting dates/times: President Jan Rosenberg announced that the First Christian Church where we have held our meetings for several years will not allow outside groups in their building for the remainder of 2020. The Community Room in the Kimberling Area Library is already booked on an on-going basis for the Quilt Guild for the third Monday of each month but is available for Tuesday mornings. She suggested we continue to hold our meetings at the Library on the third Tuesday with the Board meeting at 9 a.m. and the general meeting at 10:30 a.m. This was approved by consensus of those present. On motion (Jan O'Neill / Darlene Rutz) the group approved paying the Library the same amount as we had traditionally donated to the church for use of the facility for the meeting time.

After a short break to allow voting on the Artist of the Month entries the meeting continued.

October Program: Painting Clouds and Liquid Water

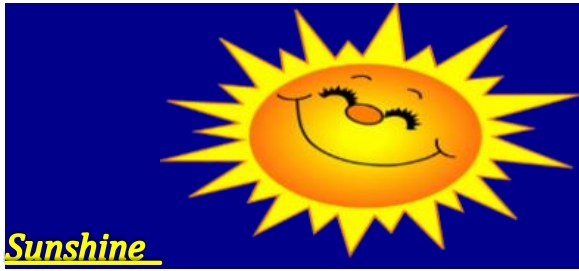

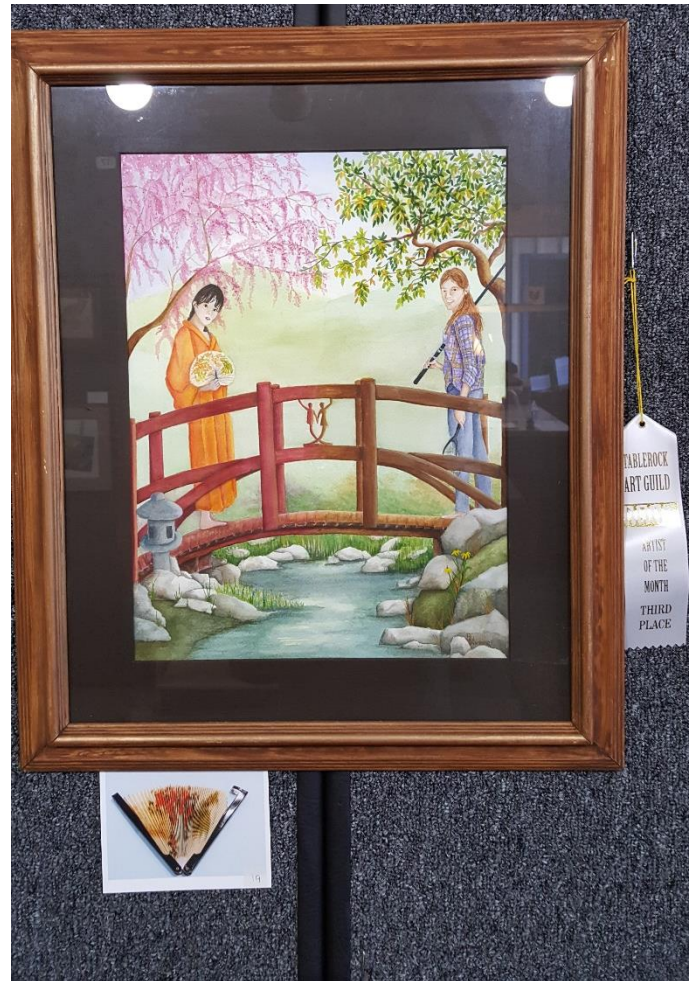
