

Maida Fanin TRAG Art Grant

Purpose: Financial assistance for a current TRAG member to participate in a non-TRAG art workshop or class.

Grant Descriptions and Restrictions:

- TRAG will award a maximum of 5 of these grants in any calendar year.
- Grants may be to attend art classes or workshops that are not presented by TRAG.
- Each grant will provide \$100 a day for a maximum award of \$300 for any one class or workshop.
- Grant award money will generally be paid directly to the workshop.

Eligibility:

- Must be an active TRAG member at the time of applying for the grant and have been an active TRAG member for two consecutive years prior to applying.
- Must not have been awarded a Maida Fanin TRAG Art Grant in the previous two years.
- Must have attended a minimum of six Guild meetings in the year prior to applying.
- Must agree to present a program at a Guild meeting to share what was learned at the workshop or class for which the grant was awarded; and, if the grant awarded is for more than \$100, must also agree to present a one or two-day workshop to TRAG members for which the members will provide their own supplies.

Selection Process:

- An initial 3-member review and selection committee, composed of Helen Long, Jan Rosenberg, and Linda Edge-Dunlap, will review and act on the applications. The committee will have a Mail Slot in the Office of the Table Rock Art Gallery.
- Applications must be submitted on the official Grant Application Form and must include a copy of the information about the workshop or class for which financial assistance is being requested. (After June 1, 2018, application forms will be available to download from the "Members Only" section of the TRAG website.)
- Applicants must submit 3 copies of the application and attached materials to the Table Rock Art Gallery as early as possible but no later than 3 weeks prior to the date of the class/workshop for which support is being requested.
